attach	(verb) to put something onto something else
common nouns	(noun) words for things that are not names; usually not capitalized
effective	(adjective) doing something successfully, as intended

efficient	(adjective) doing something without wasting time or energy
flash	(verb) to show something quickly
intended	(adjective) how something is supposed to be
parts of speech	(noun phrase) the types of words in English - such as noun, verb, etc.
prefix	(noun) a grammar unit attached to the beginning of a word

preposition	(noun) a word that shows location or relationship etc.
proper nouns	(noun) words that are names of people and places; usually capitalized
repetition	(noun) doing something again or several times
spaced	(adjective) placed (put) some distance apart
suffix	(noun) a grammar unit attached to the end of a word

verb	(noun) words that show action or existance or
vocabulary	(noun) the words that a person knows in a language
